

## **Reopening Information for Parents**

In the absence of clear guidance from the Department of Education, it is hoped this information will assist you in preparing for a return to school in August. The possibility of children attending on a part time basis with blended learning <u>cannot</u> be ruled out. As the situation is constantly evolving, further updates will be issued when they become available.

## **Key Points**

- School will open on the week beginning Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August on a **phased basis** for P2 P7. Children are divided into three intakes according to surname: A to K (e.g. Andrews to Kennedy), L, M, Mc (e.g. Lynch, Murtagh, McSwiggan) and N to Z (e.g. Noble to Zimmermann).
- We are planning to bring in all P2-P7 children on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> and Friday 28<sup>th</sup> August, however there remains a chance that COVID restrictions may prohibit this.
- From Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> September it is hoped that all children will return on a full time basis.
- In these initial days at school the emphasis will be on welcoming the children back to school after an absence of over 5 months, establishing new routines, involving the children in creating and maintaining a safe environment regular hand washing or sanitising, acceptable social distance within and around the school, maintaining safe interaction
- During Covid access to the school will be restricted. You should only visit the school if it is necessary and only after making an appointment
