As we face into the full rigours of Covid19 and the closure of schools for a considerable time, these are indeed times of unprecedented challenges. If you/your children are unable to attend school, packs will be available to collect from the assembly hall as follows:

1:00pm Primary 1 & 2 (and older siblings) 1:30pm Primary 3 & 4 (and older siblings)

2:00pm Primary 5 - 7

To reduce the risk of possible contamination, children will be asked to go straight to their classes tomorrow morning where they will be met by a teacher or assistant. Parents/guardians are asked to drop their children off and not to linger around the school. Break time and lunch time will be staggered and children will be seated apart within the classrooms where possible.

On behalf of the staff and governors I would like to thank you for your patience and support through these challenging times and pray that the whole school family is spared the worst effects of COVID19.
